DAY WISE ITINERARY:-

DAY 01 : ARRIVE LONDON (ID)

Arrive London airport complete your immigration and custom formalities and freshen up. Then proceed for a guided panoramic sightseeing introduces us to the city and its many landmarks. Continue with the city tour and view many an important landmark such as Parliament House, Big Ben, West Minister Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, Trafalgar Square, Buckingham Palace and other famous landmarks. Photo stops are made. check in. Evening free for private exploration. Indian dinner at hotel.

DAY 02 : AT LONDON (CBF, ID)

Morning Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum.

There after you are free for your own private exploration Visit nearby Oxford Street and/or the harrots at knights bridge and browse the shops. Feel London.

Optional: Tower of London – See famous Kohinoor Heera.

London Eye 135-metre (443 ft) tall giant Ferris wheel situated on the banks of the River Thames, in London, England. Dinner at the hotel/ Indian Restaurant.

DAY 03: LONDON – PARIS (BF , ID)

Post Breakfast check out & drive to Dover to take the Ferry / Euro Tunnel train to Calais. Upon arrival in Calais board your coach & transfer to Paris. Upon arrival in Paris proceed for River Seine Cruise....

Evening an hour's cruising on the river Seine past some famous landmarks for a great first introduction to Europe's most exciting city. Seine is centrally situated in Paris, a boat tour covers a great deal of the city.

Both the Left Bank and the Right Bank are visible from the boat.

DAY 04: AT PARIS (BF , ID)

Morning proceed for a guided panoramic sightseeing tour covers the famous landmarks such as Arc De Triumph, Concord Square, Opera House, a drive through the Rue St. Honore (which houses all famous fashion houses of the world), which we shall pass by with photo stops... the images of which you would have seen and visualized before and possibly had a glimpse during the Seine cruise and now you see in reality.

Photo stops are made. Afternoon ascend to Eiffel Tower ... And obvious facial blemish to their loved city skyline! Enjoy a panoramic view of the city from the 2nd Floor.

An evening out at Lido 2ND show... one of the famous night clubs of Paris with an illuminations drive.

DAY 5: AT PARIS

Morning after breakfast the day is free for you to explore this Romantic city at your own pace. You can also choose an optional activity from the option given below:

DAY 06: PARIS – BRUSSELS- AMSTERDAM (BF , ID)

Post breakfast check out and proceed towards Brussels through expressway. Up on arrival enjoy an orientation tour of Brussels.. Panoramic viewing of the Grand Place, ManikenPis
Later drive towards Amsterdam.... Enroute viewing Windmill, cheese and Clog Factory (see how they make wooden shoes called clogs and paint them). Time at Dam Square. Indian Dinner.

DAY 07: AMSTERDAM – COLOGNE (BF , ID)

Post Breakfast proceed to Amsterdam City Centre for some free time. **Optional** Canal Cruise.
Later Proceed to Cologne. Upon arrival visit the renowned Cologne Cathedral. Indian Dinner.
Check in , Overnight at the hotel

DAY 08: COLOGNE – LK.TITISEE (BF, ID)
LK.TITISEE – RHINE FALLS – ZURICH

Morning board your coach and drive through the famous German Autobahn to Lake Titisee in the heart of Black Forest. Spend your time at lake front surrounding by beautiful black forest. You can buy Cuckoo clocks here. Free time here.
Post lunch break board your coach and drive through the beautiful German country side to Rhine Falls. Some free time at Rhine Falls. Then drive to Zurich. Indian dinner.

DAY 09: AT ZURICH - EXCURSION TO MT.TITLIS AND LUCERNE (CBF,ID)

Morning proceed to the Mt. Titlis Cable Car station short distance away from your hotel. There a Cable Car ride in 3 stages takes us to MT. TITLIS.. A thrilling experience. On top enjoy exciting cliff walk.
The last part of cable car way leads above the glacier.
Afternoon return to base station and proceed for Lucerne. On arrival do an orientation tour of the beautiful resort. Walk across the wooden bridge (the oldest in the world). Shopping at Bucherer shop. Some free time at Lake Front. Evening return to hotel. Indian dinner.

DAY 10: AT ZURICH – OPTIONAL: EXCURSION TO JUNGFRAU & INTERLAKEN (BF, ID)

Day at leisure. Free to explore.

Optional: Excursion Jung Frau with lunch.

Morning we proceed to Lauterbrunnen railway station for Jung Frau by mountain RACKRAIL... the highest mountain railway in Europe and see the magnificent ICE PALACE... Adequate time at the top. Indian lunch at Bollywood restaurant on top.
Evening return to hotel. Indian dinner.

DAY 11: ZURICH-PISA - FLORENCE AREA (BF, ID)

Morning we drive to Pisa via picturesque Lugano and the beautiful Lake Como area enroute we also drive through the mighty St. Gothard's Tunnel
On arrival visit the world famous Leaning Tower and Square of Miracle. Some free time.

Then we proceed to Florence... the Renaissance Capital. Indian Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

DAY 12 : FLORENCE AREA-ROME (BF , ID)

Morning post breakfast we proceed to the starting point of a fascinating walking tour of Renaissance Florence of the *Piazza Della Signoria* area... a virtual outdoor sculpture gallery. View *Piazza Palazzo Vecchio*, *Giotto's Tower*, *Pizza Duomo*, and the Baptistry with its colorful mosaics and lastly Lorenzo Ghiberti's famous gilded doors that made none other than the great master Michel Angelo exclaim "*These Doors are fit to stand at the Gates of Paradise*".

Later we depart for the eternal city Rome passing through the scenic Tuscany district.

Upon arrival some free at city Centre & Trevi fountain. Indian Dinner & Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 13 : AT ROME (BF , ID)

Morning Post breakfast meet our guide and head for Vatican. Visit the the *St. Peter's Square* and the *St. Peter's church*... seat of the Pope... and which hosts the famous *Pieta by Michael Angelo* and the only work the master ever signed, the *Dome by Bernini* among many other priceless treasures. Then visit the Sistine Chapel with the stunning Frescos by Michel Angelo.

City tour commences thereafter. View the Imperial area and Rome's most famous landmarks - The Colosseum, the Roman Forum, the Arch De Constantine, The Pantheon, the Vittoria Emanuel monument.

Indian dinner and check into hotel.

DAY 14: ROME-VENICE (BF, ID)

Board your coach and drive to Venice. At Tronchetto we board your private steamer (Vaperetto) for transfer to St. Marks Square.

Feel the magic of this unique city in a sight seeing tour. Its Canals are its roads, its vaperettos are its buses, gently gliding along its canals with brilliant mansions on both sides. Napoleon called it the World's biggest drawing room. Free time for you to feed the pigeons at St. Marks Square or visit a Venetian Murano Glass factory or the many shops around St. Marks Square where you can pick up beautiful Glassware and Crochette work.

DAY 15 : VENICE-INNSBRUCK-WATTENS (BF, ID)

Board your coach and drive to Innsbruck through the stunning dolomites. We arrive into Austria as we cross the Brenner Pass. Lunch at Indian restaurant and onto Wattens ... a short distance away. Visit Swarovski's amazing Crystal World and its futuristic creations.

After Swarovski board your coach and drive to Innsbruck. Do an orientation tour. free time at Maria Terresa Square. Indian dinner. Check into hotel.

DAY 16 : INNSBRUCK-SALZBURG-VIENNA (BF, ID)

Post Breakfast proceed towards Salzburg & upon arrival enjoy an walking tour of the Mozart's Birth place. Post tour we continue on our scenic journey to the charming imperial Capital Vienna. Arrive Vienna Indian dinner and check into hotel.

DAY 17 : AT VIENNA (BF, ID)

Morning the Grand city tour covers - the Old city centre, including Wenceslas Square, Charles Bridge, the Old Town Square and the Jewish Quarter, culminating at the fabulous Prague Castle (Hradcany) on the other side of the River Vltava. There after we leave you at the Old Quarter with the Wenceslas Square nearby. Stroll the streets... see the illuminations and then you will appreciate our decision to include Prague.

Afternoon & evening is free for you to shop. We will leave you at a Crystal factory outlet. Here you will find the best of Crystals made anywhere ... fine Bohemian crystal and cut (etched) glass unmatched anywhere in the world.

**DAY 20 : PRAGUE – BRATISLAVA (BF , ID)
BRATISLAVA – BUDAPEST**

Morning proceed to beautiful Slovakian city Bratislava.

From the banks of the Danube along the way, you will see the Slovak National Theater and Slovak Philharmonic; many beautiful churches; the inverted pyramid of the Slovak Radio Station; the Grassalkovich/Presidential Palace, once the archbishop's summer palace and now the residence of the government; Parliament; the Town Walls; and St. Martin's Cathedral.

In Old town You will see the Main Square; Roland Fountain, the oldest fountain in the city; St. Martin's Cathedral, the coronation Cathedral of Hungarian Kings; ancient St. Clare's Church; St. Michael's Gate; Venturska Street, center of the vibrant musical life of the city; many palaces from the time of Empress Maria Theresa; the beautiful Slovak National Theatre and Slovak Philharmonic; the Primate's Palace; and many other remarkable sites.

Post tour drive to the beautiful Hungarian capital of Budapest.... impressive in its charm and comprising the twin cities of Buda and Pest situated on two sides of the River Danube. Check into hotel. Indian dinner.

DAY 21 : AT BUDAPEST (BF, ID)

Morning a sightseeing tour will introduce you to this fascinating city, including Heroes' Square, Gellert Hill, the Castle district, St. Matthew's church and the Fishermen's bastion in the Pest area located on a hill, with its spectacular view over the city.

Late afternoon cruise on river Danube will be provided today. You will then be able to appreciate what made Johan Strauss compose "Blue Danube" Probably the most popular composition.

Budapest is bright at night with the Landmark buildings brilliantly lit up and a fascinating sight. The Pedestrian area as well and you must walk around to really feel the place.

Indian Dinner & Overnight at the hotel.
