End with Khan Khalili Bazaar one of the old markets in Middle East& Africa.

The *khan* was located at the middle of Cairo's most important zone of economic activity, and later sultans also built commercial establishments nearby, including Sultan <u>Qaytbay</u>'s *wikala* (another word meaning caravanserai south of the Al-Azhar Mosque

Later in the eveningtransfer to railway station to take the train to Aswan

Dinner will be served on board. Overnight on first class sleeper train

## DAY 3: ASWAN

After Breakfast on board & disembark from train. Arrive Aswan railway station & then visit the **High Dam & Philae Temple.** 

## Later transfer to the 5\* Cruise ship (Aswan - Luxor 3 nights)
