IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT!

Czech Republic welcomes fully vaccinated Indians



- Traveler's who are fully vaccinated by the EU approved vaccines can now enter Czech Republic by providing their digital vaccination certificate after 14 days of taking the second dose (Only if the airline requires a RT-PCR test, will the traveler have to provide the same)
- Traveler's will also have to fill in the arrival form (the exception have children under the age of 6)
- Accommodation facilities, restaurants, theaters, sports grounds, swimming pools, gardens, castles and some other places will accommodate guests who show either a negative test for coronavirus, a vaccination certificate, or a document on having undergone Covid-19.



Recent Developments





- Non vaccinated children below the age of 6 years are allowed to enter the Czech Republic
- Traveler's between the age group of 6 + years up to the age of 18 years will to provide a negative RT- PCR test not longer than 72 hours before starting the travel or an antigen test not longer than 48 hours prior to travel
- For non-vaccinated Indians you may travel by providing a negative RT-PCR test 72 prior to travel or an antigen test not longer than 48 hours prior to travel
- Travelers who are not fully vaccinated will need to undergo self-isolation according to specifications


